- ✓ Knowledge of MS Office/Internet applications

The Internship is paid. The amount of compensation will be disclosed to selected candidates (only).

The selection process will be conducted in two stages:

1. *Written Assignment* – All applicants will be invited for this stage simultaneously. It will involve working on a practical problem assigned to the group by BLC attorneys. Each applicant will have to work on the task individually. The written assignment shall be prepared in English. The writing process shall not take more than 2-3 hours.
2. *Interview* – based on the results of the first stage, short listed candidates will be invited for an interview. Final decision will be made by BLC based on both – written and verbal skills of the applicant.
